



Policy on Transporting Children to and from Matches and Training

- Parents and carers must be notified that parents and carers are responsible for the safe delivery and collection of their children for matches or training.
- At the beginning of the season, Carlisle Cricket Club will ensure as far as possible, that information is distributed which relates to all planned away fixtures or competitions to provide parents with the opportunities to make appropriate arrangements.
- Coaches and club staff will be responsible for children when on the club premises or on arrival at opponent's cricket grounds.
- It is not the responsibility of the coach or the team manager to transport, or arrange to transport, the children to and from the club or match.
- Carlisle CC must receive permission from parents / carers via the Player Profile form, for children to participate in all competitions and away fixtures / events.
- At the beginning of the season Carlisle CC will try to establish with parents and carers a 'pick up and drop off' policy which specifically addresses matters such as the late collection of children. This will help to establish club and parental expectations and give guidance to club officials should an incident arise during the season.
